## Paramedic

### **Brief Description of Job:**

Delivers, implements, and evaluates care of assigned patients under the supervision of a Registered Nurse. Accountable for care administered to patients during the shift.

Responsible for adhering to all Medicare requirements, standards of care and established policies and procedures.

Works effectively with the health care team.

### **Essential Functions:**

- Administers nursing care to patients under the direction of the registered nurse; includes assessing patients, implementing patient's plan of care and evaluating the patient's response to care.
- Provides patient/family or care giver education as directed.
- Is knowledgeable in delegation of tasks to certified nursing assistants.
- Maintains knowledge of documentation requirements needed for patient's records.
- Works under direct supervision using the Ringgold County Hospital Policies.
- Maintains knowledge of equipment set-up, maintenance and use, i.e., IV Pumps, monitoring equipment, drainage/suction devices, etc.
- Maintains confidentiality regarding all patient/personnel information.
- Initiates emergency support measures, ACLS, protecting patient from injury.
- Assists the Registered Nurse in ER, utilizing Paramedic protocol and Ringgold County Hospital Policies.
- Works assigned shift/shifts, weekends and holidays, as scheduled.
- Assists with patient care duties/tasks, i.e., hygiene, ambulation, elimination, etc.
- Assists with clerical/ward clerk duties, i.e., answering phones and call lights, maintenance of chart, etc.
- Maintains patient care supplies, equipment and environment.
- Provides orientation/education for staff, students and health care members as directed.
- Effectively assumes job responsibilities of ancillary support during absence.
